

Paying for Childcare - now or in the future?

Still time to register for
Childcare Vouchers and save on your
childcare costs but **act now!**

Sign up to Childcare Vouchers now or you could miss out on saving £££

Childcare Vouchers are closing to new entrants on 4 October. After this, if you are not already registered, you will not be able to join and your options will be reduced in terms of accessing financial support with childcare costs. Each working parent can **save up to £933 per year** on childcare costs using Childcare Vouchers, with a family saving up to £1,866 if both parents use the scheme.

A parent can join the scheme from when their first child is born, and Childcare Vouchers can be used for any children under the age of 16 (17 if they have a disability) if you are paying for ANY FORM of registered childcare. **CAN YOU AFFORD TO MISS OUT?**

Even if you are not currently paying for registered childcare, but might in the future (eg if you are currently off on maternity leave), you can join the scheme now to protect your future options. You can join by contributing a nominal amount, for example £1 a month.

Act now – to join the scheme, you will need to have arrangements in place through your payroll **before 4 October!**
